We have experienced many successes this year, but we have also seen many difficulties. Just to name a few of the heartaches; Ghana had an extremely dry rainy season this year. Almost everyone's maize crop was destroyed in the drought. Sammy's was no different. He did not get enough maize to last the coming year of feeding the widows and orphans. Another heartache happened with the rabbit colony. A virus spread through the colony killing more than 500 rabbits in 7 days. Only $\underline{8}$ survived.

We can't know the reason for these calamities, but we can trust in the Lord and in His Will. We accept what we are given and remain faithful to the call in our lives and ministries.

Life & Death

We rejoice in the life of this baby girl. The mother, a 14 year old girl, decided to end her near-term pregnancy. Since abortion is illegal in Ghana, she took some "morning after" pills. Sammy intervened and rushed the mother to the hospital. The baby was delivered by c-section and put in an incubator for five

days. Sammy was the only person standing between this precious child and death. Both baby and mother are doing fine. Through his intervention Sammy now has an avenue to teach this young mother about the Lord.

integral part of all that God is doing in and through Sammy. There are two young girls enrolled in a sewing internship. Sammy purchased the machines and necessary supplies. When the internship is finished they will be able to run their own sewing business. Another young girl was given



a position in a hair salon with the same possibilities. Sammy has also set up two young boys with internships; one making window frames, and the other auto body repair. These positions are designed to help the physical life of these orphans, but of course the main focus is teaching about Jesus Christ and His Salvation.



God has taken us physically out of Ghana, but our hearts and desires are still there. He has given us an ability to be completely involved in so many ways through Sammy. Our hearts BURST with joy when we see all that God is doing.
